No membership or entry fee in section S.
2. All articles competing in this department must be the work of the exhibitor, and not previously shown at Killarney Fair.
3. The Committee reserves the right to reject or accept conditionally all entries or applications at any time.
4. In the absence of competition in any section, or if the article exhibited is of inferior quality, the judges will award only such prizes as they think deserving.  
**THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
5. No exhibitor is permitted to enter more than one article in any class.
6. The Directors will take every possible precaution to ensure the safety of all exhibits brought to the exhibition. They will give all assistance in their power towards the care and recovery of same, but will not make payment for the value thereof.
7. Previous to the fair phone Margaret Nichol (523-8678), Shirley Keyes (523-4526) for entry number. Entry tags maybe picked up at Trinkets and Treasures (in Mall) or Shirley Keyes 646 Broadway Ave. Only one exhibitor may list items on each entry form. Fees to be paid at time of entry.
8. Exhibits and entries will be accepted in the Homecraft Display Building the Thursday before the Fair, between **3.00 p.m.** and **4.30 p.m.** and **6 p.m.** and **9 p.m.** **all entries must be in the hands of the section director by 9:00 pm sharp.**
9. Homecraft Building will be closed to the public at **6:00 p.m.** on Saturday, the day of the fair. Exhibits to be picked up at **6:30 p.m.** Directors will not be responsible for any article after **7:00 p.m.** check ad's in 2017 for any time changes, or additional classes.  
**In the event of incimate weather and the fair is called off earlier, the building may close earlier at directors discretion and exhibits may be picked up earlier.**
10. Prize money will be available at **6:00 p.m.** Saturday. Trophies and special awards available at time of exhibit pickup.
11. Any monetary corrections to entry forms will be adjusted at time of prize distribution.
